

- •It summarizes the accomplishments from 2008-2012
- 24 Action Plans (8 new)
- •Since 2008, \$15.9 million have been matched by \$10.4 million
- Total \$26.3 million towards restoration projects



#### **Habitat Created and Restored**

- •Twelve habitat restoration projects have created over 70 acres of habitat: mangrove, spartina, maritime hammock, seagrass beds, oyster and artificial reefs
- •2 public Boardwalks that provides access to habitat restoration projects
- •8 Monitoring Projects
- •Summarized in Appendix B of the Management Plan WQ Projects included:
- 1.a new monitoring plan (3 stations deleted), 5 years WQ analysis
- 2.3 stormwater treatment projects treating the runoff from an area of 526 acres
- 3.2 Septic to Centralized Sewer projects taking septic systems offline
